Highlights from the January Meeting: The Dynamics of Organizational Change

Julie Ray, EdD & Tracey Tapp, MSOD, introduced the Five Secrets to Navigating Change Successfully as: 1. having a plan, 2. involving others, 3. communicate, communicate, communicate, 4. understanding the process people go through and the role of the change agent during each phase, and 5. ensur-

ing that the organizational structures, systems, and processes support the change. Attendees learned that using 7x7 is the way to make information stick: saying what you have to say 7 times in 7 different ways. Employees’ reaction to change was summarized by SARA: Shock, Anger, Resistance, and

Acceptance. Finally, everyone had fun with an activity in which attendees were assigned the role of change agent, strongly opposed to change, or uncommitted. Holding a rope, agents had to convince the others to form a rectangle. It was an effective example of the difficulty in change.
